

Expedition: What's involved?

Before deciding whether to apply for Expedition, we want you to consider carefully whether you have the capacity to commit fully to the programme. Across the year you'll need to commit at least *2 days per month*. The shape of those days will vary across the year.

The time commitment works out at approx *2 days per month in most months (½ a day per week)*, plus two 48 hour residential events per year. There is a significant element of reading and writing involved, which requires self-discipline and good time management.

Overview of the Year

- **A three hour tutorial per month.** This will involve both pre- and post reading, along with discussion during each tutorial.

Residentials

- Residential sessions will include *teaching from practitioners*.
- **Residential 1: 17th - 19th September 2024** - in Newcastle.
- **Residential 2: 28th - 30th January 2025** (tbc) - in Newcastle.
- Accommodation and meals will be provided.

What do fees cover? What other costs are involved?

- Fees cover all tuition, mentoring, accommodation and meals.
- You will need to budget for travel to residential events.
- You will need a book budget between £100-£200 per year to purchase set texts and additional texts related to your elective specialism. You may be able to borrow some texts; a few texts will be provided as PDFs free of charge.
